February

First Sunday: Pisco Sour Day

Carnival (February)

Picapica water games, and all weekends from February, parade of floats in Miraflores and stop cortamontes in districts and provincial clubs.

Festival of grapes, wine and boating Lunahuaná (February) Lunahuaná, south of Lima (Cañete) is the largest producer of wine in the region and an ideal place to practice adventure sports. During the festival consists canoeing championships, paragliding, trekking, gliding, mountain biking, fishing twine and net.

March

Harvest Festival (March)

Program of harvest celebrations in the traditional district of Surco, with choice of queen and visits to wineries.

Easter (March-April)

Movable feast during which the faithful come to the main churches of colonial downtown Lima to reaffirm their religious faith.

April

National Competition "Caballo de Paso" (April)

Occasion to celebrate spirited individuals and characteristic step in Peruvian horses Mamacona (Lurin).

June

Fiesta de las Cruces

Location: Lima, Apurímac, Ayacucho, Junín, Ica, Cusco
Date: May 03

In this event, widespread in the highlands, members of each community is organized to decorate your cross, and preparing for the procession to neighboring churches. The celebration is intimately tied to appreciation for a good harvest that farmers offer their deities from pre-Hispanic times.

St. Peter and St. Paul

Location: Chorrillos and Lurin (Lima), San José (Lambayeque)
Date: June 29

In the villages of the mountains is carried out in conjunction with the cleaning of communal irrigation channels, a true celebration of water. In the San Pedro coast has been chosen as the patron saint of fishermen and worshiped in the creeks of Chorrillos and Lurin, Lima, and San Jose, located 13 km north of Chiclayo. The ceremony takes place near the mouth of the Lambayeque River where, according to legend, landed the founding god Naylamp. It leads to the saint, amid incense, chants and prayers to the shores of the sea to embark on a journey in order to bless the waters for a good fishing year.



July

Fiestas Patrias (28 and 29 July)

On July 29, on the occasion of Independence Day, is made an impressive stop military-civilian on the Champ de Mars and Te Deum in the Cathedral, attended by all national authorities. Floats and fireworks in Miraflores.

August

Cañete Week (4th week in August)

Cañete is one of the largest sites of Afro-Peruvian culture, whose samples are seen in these dates.

October

Water Festival (1st Sunday in October)

Communal work of cleaning of water channels as a celebration to Pachamama in San Pedro de Casta (Canta).

Virgen del Rosario

Location: Lima, Ancash, Apurimac, Arequipa and Cusco

Date: October 04

La Virgen del Rosario is the patron saint of the Dominican order, who were in charge of the Confraternity of the slaves during the colonial era, so many times your image is accompanied by an icon with the letter "S" supported by a nail.

Month of the Lord of Miracles, October 18, 27 and 28

Procession of the Lord of Miracles

The Procession of Señor de los Milagros takes place during the month of October, when Lima wears purple for the most spectacular and popular religious festival, where habits, nougat and scapulars Pachacamilla of Christ flood the city. This procession gathers the largest number of devotees from South America to pay homage to Christ purple, with singing and praise as the image throughout the city



October/november

Bullfighting season

In commemoration of the Lord of Miracles, in the Plaza de Acho is performed Bullfighting Fair of the same name reaching the top bullfighters in Spain and other countries of America. These traditional bullfights are the delight of the Lima from the colonial period.
